THIRD COUNTRY (DATA PROTECTION)
REGULATIONS

4th July, 2003

LEGAL NOTICE 155 of 2003, as amended by Legal Notice 426 of 2007.

- 1.** The title of these regulations is the Third Country (Data Protection Act) Regulations. Citation.
 - 2.** Unless otherwise stated in these regulations, the definitions contained in the Data Protection Act shall apply. Interpretation.
Cap. 440.
 - 3.** These regulations shall apply to transfers of personal data to third countries. Applicability.
 - 4.** A third country shall be any country that at the relevant time is not a Member State of the European Union. Third country.
 - 5.** Prior to transferring personal data to a third country, data controllers shall notify the Commissioner of any transfer of data resulting from a processing operation. Notification.
 - 6.** Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with these regulations shall be liable to an administrative fine not exceeding twenty-three thousand and two hundred and ninety-three euro and seventy-three cents (23,293.73) for each violation and two thousand and three hundred and twenty-nine euro and thirty-seven cents (2,329.37) for each day during which such violation persists, which fine shall be determined and imposed by the Commissioner. Administrative fines and sanctions.
